

Ação de formação acreditada no AGML: *Creating a democratic adult education classroom*

No cumprimento do seu Plano de Formação, o Centro Qualifica do AGML, em colaboração com o CFAES, preparou a ação acreditada pelo CCPFC, *Creating a democratic adult education classroom/ Criar ambientes democráticos na Educação de Adultos*, que terá como *keynote speaker* o perito grego Konstatinos Oikonomou.

Calendarizada para decorrer entre os dias **3 e 7 de junho** na Escola Secundária de Santa Maria, esta ação de 25 horas (15 horas presenciais e 10 horas de trabalho autónomo), totalmente gratuita, insere-se nas comemorações dos *50 anos do 25 de abril*. Financiada pelo programa Erasmus+, destina-se a todos os profissionais que se dedicam à formação de adultos, podendo ser também frequentada por docentes de outros níveis de ensino. A língua de comunicação é o inglês.

Konstatinos OIKONOMOU é *Master of Arts – MA, Classics and classical Languages, Literatures and Linguistics* pela Aristotle University of Thessaloniki; foi subdiretor e professor na *1st and 2nd Second Chance Schools of Larissa*, na Grécia.

Desempenha, atualmente, o cargo de Consultor Educacional no Ministério da Educação, Aprendizagem ao Longo da Vida e Assuntos Religiosos.

Summary

Creating a democratic adult education classroom

The purpose of the course is to discuss why and how adult educators can make their groups of adult learners essentially democratic and boost critical thinking, which is a presupposition of democracy in society. Inspired extensively by Stephen Brookfield's foundational work, the course will offer participants a comprehensive array of methods and techniques to create a democratic "setting" in their classes of adult learners. Topics to be addressed are: the nature and the significance of the democratic learning environment in adult education; the skills that adults need to develop to become critically active and democratic citizens; the pedagogical and teaching skills needed on behalf of the educator for the application of democratic principles in adult education; the presentation and implementation of adult-centered practices that make democratic classrooms possible.



Dr Konstantinos Oikonomou studied Literature and Education at various Greek universities. He also studied Adult Education and earned a doctorate in Educational Leadership. He is a Secondary Education Teacher and has taught humanistic subjects in various settings including Second Chance Schools and formal education. Currently, he serves as an Educational Consultant/Inspector and has under his supervision and guidance a large number of schools and teachers in the region of Thessaly.
